**Rinse and repeat.**











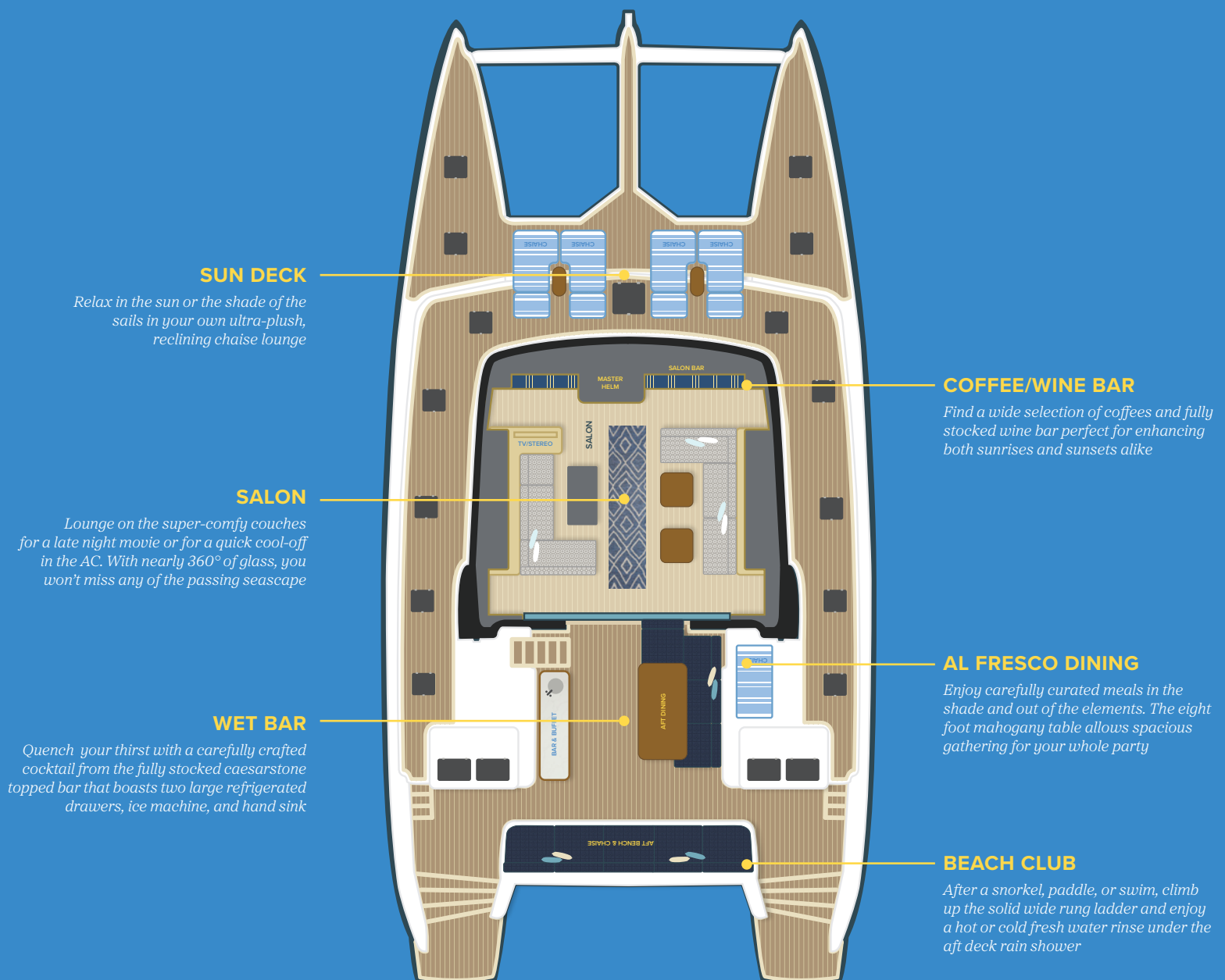

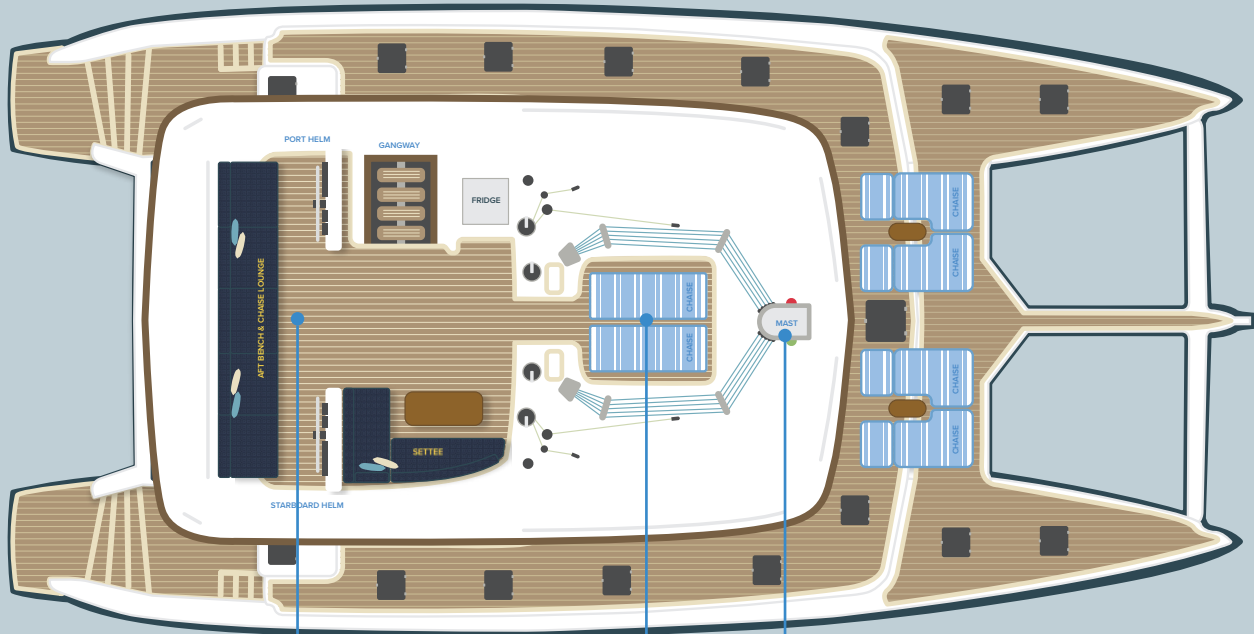

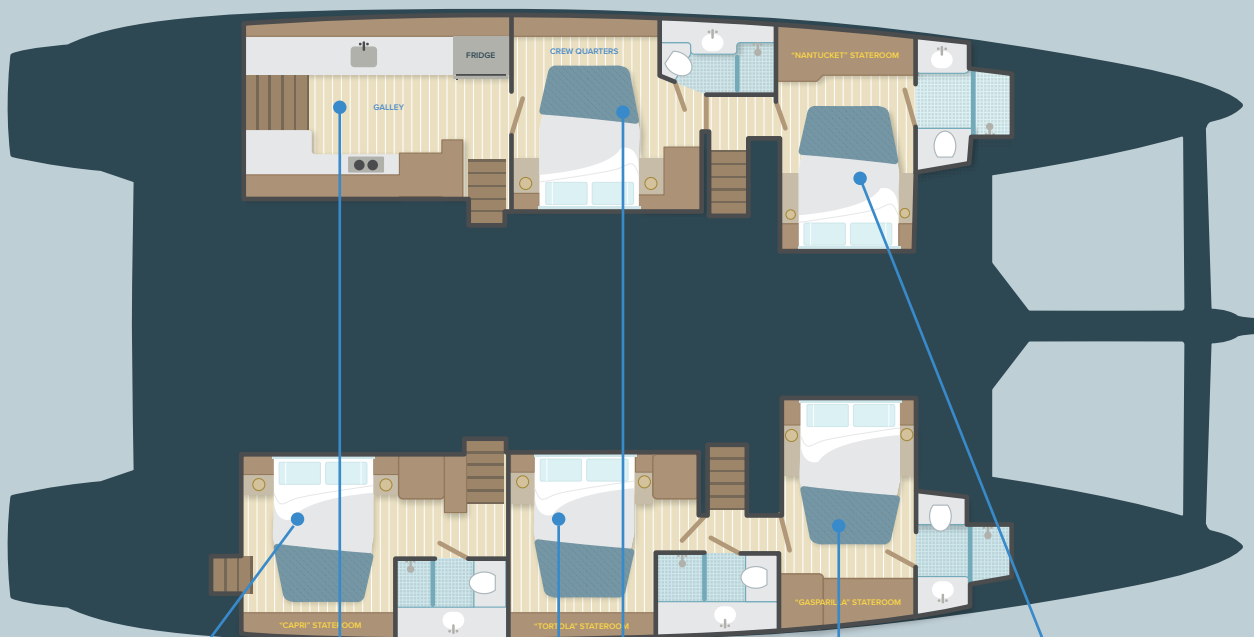

# The Hamptons

### Day One: Sag Harbor

Pick up your charter in style by booking a picnic boat for 1<sup>st</sup> Watch and join *Andromeda* out at anchor just outside the harbor. After being greeted with a cocktail, relax on your private oasis and explore the surrounding waters in the tender. Enjoy the untouched beauty of Shelter Island's Mashomack Nature Preserve or relax aboard the vessel. Finish the evening with a quality meal tailored to your liking by the onboard chef.

### Day Two: Sag Harbor to Montauk

**17 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 45 Minute Sail**

Montauk is a quick sail away and offers beaches, delicious food, hiking, or scenic biking. Enjoy the day in town and have dinner ashore at Duryea's. Your Crew will be on hand to assist with anything you need to enjoy a perfect day.

### Day Three: Montauk to Block Island

**19 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 45 Minute Sail**

A few hours at sea lands you at the entrance to Great Salt Pond Bay, Block Island. Settle in for a relaxing and calm night under the stars. Take the tender ashore and visit one of the many lively bars and restaurants. Rent a moped and ride the beach roads to the dramatic Mohegan Bluffs.

### Day Four: Block Island to Greenport

**35 Nautical Miles - 5 Hour Sail**

Pick up anchor after breakfast and make your way back in to Gardiners Bay, north of Shelter Island tucked in to Dering Harbor to explore Shelter Island and the town of Greenport. Enjoy some oysters on the docks at Little Creek Oyster Farm & Market.

### Day Five: Greenport to Sag Harbor

**9 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

One final cruise to finish out your summer Hamptons getaway. Make your way west around Shelter Island and back to Sag Harbor for drop off.







## POPULAR ITINERARY

# Long Island Sound

### Day One: New York City to Greenwich

**19 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 45 Minute Sail**

Hop aboard a B&G Daychaser and cruise by Lady Liberty on your way to *Andromeda* with spectacular views of the East River.

### Day Two: Greenwich to Port Jefferson

**38 Nautical Miles - 5 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Continue down Long Island's northern shore to Port Jefferson, one of Long Island's hidden treasures, that combines beauty and history with picturesque water views and a rich maritime heritage.

### Day Three: Port Jefferson to Thimble Islands

**23 Nautical Miles - 3 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Enjoy breakfast while sailing to the Thimble Islands. Spend your day with a paddle to Outer Island & discover Stewart B. McKinney National Wildlife Refuge, accessible only by boat.

### Day Four: Thimble Islands

The Thimbles are a boating paradise with plenty to explore by tender or paddle. Enjoy an afternoon in Stony Creek browsing shops and art galleries.

### Day Five: Thimble Islands to Greenport

**37 Nautical Miles - 5 Hour Sail**

Take the tender into town for a day of shopping and dining in Greenport. Enjoy oysters on the docks at Little Creek Oyster Farm & Market. Finish your day relaxing on the sundeck with your favorite cocktail.

### Day Six: Greenport to Sag Harbor

**8 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

On your last day, awaken to the sounds of the water as you casually sail through Gardiners Bay toward Sag Harbor for drop off.

# Newport & Approaches

### Day One: Watch Hill to Newport

**30 Nautical Miles - 3 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Pick up your charter in style by booking a picnic boat for 1<sup>st</sup> Watch and join *Andromeda* out at anchor just outside the harbor. After being greeted with a cocktail, relax on your private oasis and get comfortable for the sail ahead. Take in Rhode Island's south coast as you sail through the sound to Narragansett Bay. Cruise by historic properties and famous boats as you make your way into Newport Harbor.

### Day Two: Newport

There is so much to do in historic downtown Newport. Stroll along Thames Street and check out the vibrant shops or take a tour of the famous gilded age mansions. Head out in the afternoon to Mackerel Cove and enjoy swimming or paddleboarding in picturesque Jamestown.

### Day Three: Newport to Block Island

**22 Nautical Miles - 3 Hour Sail**

A few hours at sea lands you at the entrance to Great Salt Pond Bay, Block Island. Settle in for a relaxing and calm night under the stars. Take the tender ashore and visit one of the many lively bars and restaurants. Rent a moped and cruise the beach roads to the dramatic Mohegan Bluffs.

### Day Four: Block Island to Fishers Island

**24 Nautical Miles - 3 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Pick up anchor after breakfast and make your way back north to Fishers Island. Known for its pristine beaches and secluded cove, Fishers Island is a great place to tuck away and enjoy all the amenities that the boat has to offer.

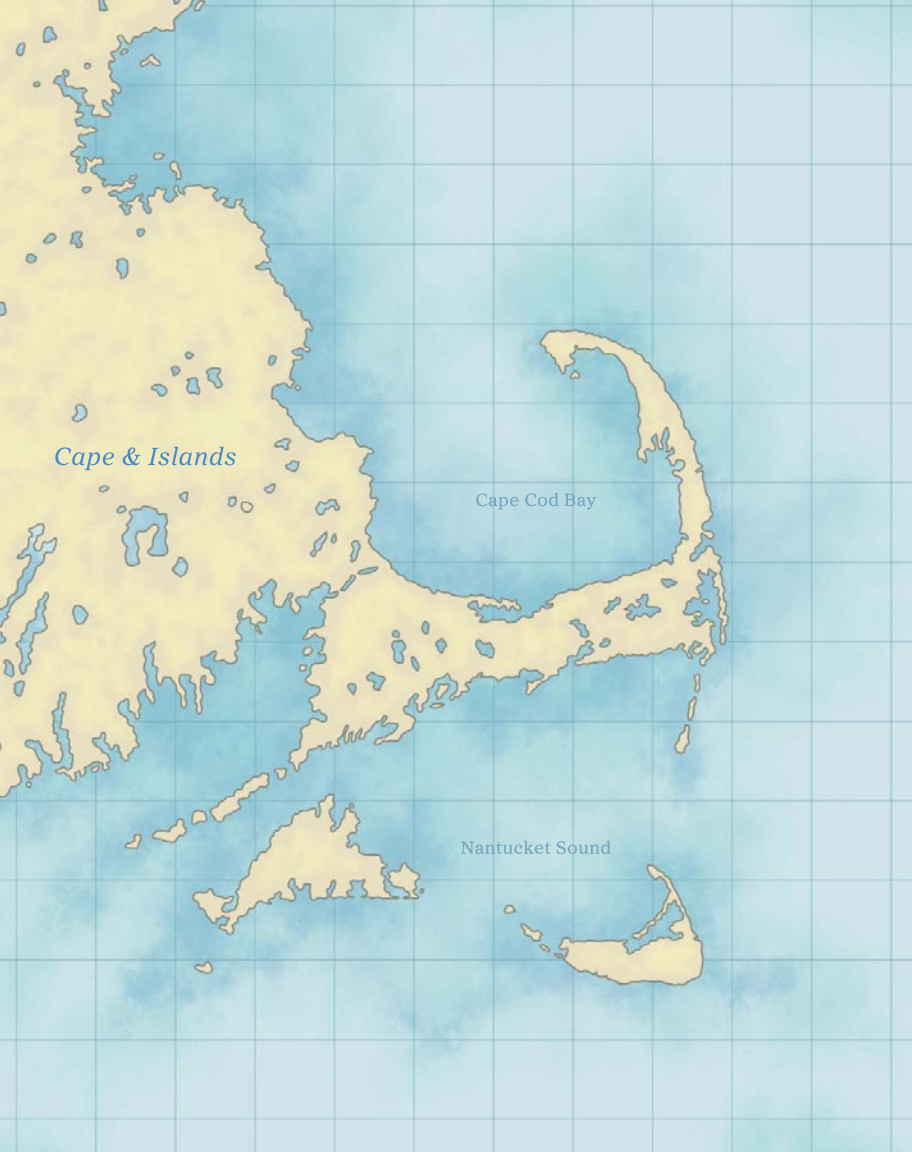
### Day Five: Fishers Island to Watch Hill

**6 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour Sail**

One final morning on the sound to finish out your summer sailing getaway. Enjoy a sun soaked breakfast and take in the multitude of local lighthouses during a slow sail back to Watch Hill.

# The Cape & Islands

### Day One: Falmouth Harbor to Martha's Vineyard

**6 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour Sail**

Get comfortable aboard while you make a short sail to Martha's Vineyard. After enjoying a carefully curated lunch onboard, spend the afternoon exploring the quaint shops and historic bakeries of Vineyard Haven. Finish the day watching the sunset and dinner under the stars.

### Day Two: Vineyard Haven to Edgartown

**9.5 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

A short sail away is Edgartown. Enjoy the views of the west side of Martha's Vineyard and drop your anchor just outside of town. Edgartown has a number of shops and restaurants to enjoy for the afternoon.

### Day Tree: Edgartown to Nantucket Boat Basin

**22 Nautical Miles - 3 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Set sail and relax while you make your way to Nantucket. Bask in the sun as you lay under the sails and watch some of New England's most iconic ships sail past.

### Day Four: Nantucket

Spend the day on Nantucket. Take the tender into town for shopping and dining or grab a Hinckley to bring you deep into the basin and lounge on Nantucket's most secluded beaches. Finish the day with a sunset sail with cocktails and dinner on board.

### Day Five: Nantucket to Falmouth Harbor

**26.4 Nautical Miles - 4 Hour Sail**

Awaken to the sounds of the lapping waves as the Crew expertly navigates back to Falmouth Harbor.

# Downeast Maine

### Day One: Southwest Harbor to Stonington

**21 Nautical Miles - 3 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Set sail from Southwest Harbor and moor at Stonington Harbor for the night. Head into town to experience quaint shops and eclectic art galleries. Enjoy a lobster dinner prepared by the chef onboard.

### Day Two: Stonington to Vinalhaven

**17 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

There's plenty to do and see once you arrive in Vinalhaven, known for having one of the biggest lobster fishing fleets in the world. Go for a paddle along the coastline before touring a local lobster boat. Vinalhaven is Maine's largest boat-accessible-only island.

### Day Three: Vinalhaven to Swans Island

**18 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 45 Minute Sail**

Begin the trip to Swans Island in the morning in order to get a full day in. Visit Fine Sand Beach to explore and hunt for sea glass followed by a picnic on the beach.

### Day Four: Swans Island to Seal Harbor

**19 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 45 Minute Sail**

Enjoy the sail to "postcard-perfect" Seal Harbor. Take in the lobster boats, yachts, and seals as you pull into the harbor! Spend the rest of the day exploring the village or strolling Little Pond. Seal Harbor is famous for the John Rockefeller Estate and much of the carriage path network and public space was donated by the family.

### Day Five: Seal Harbor

The ideal last day in Maine is to be spent discovering the 47,000 acres of Acadia National Park. Hike up Cadillac Mountain to see moose & bears or head down to Thunder Hole. End the adventure at Jordan Pond House for popovers and tea.

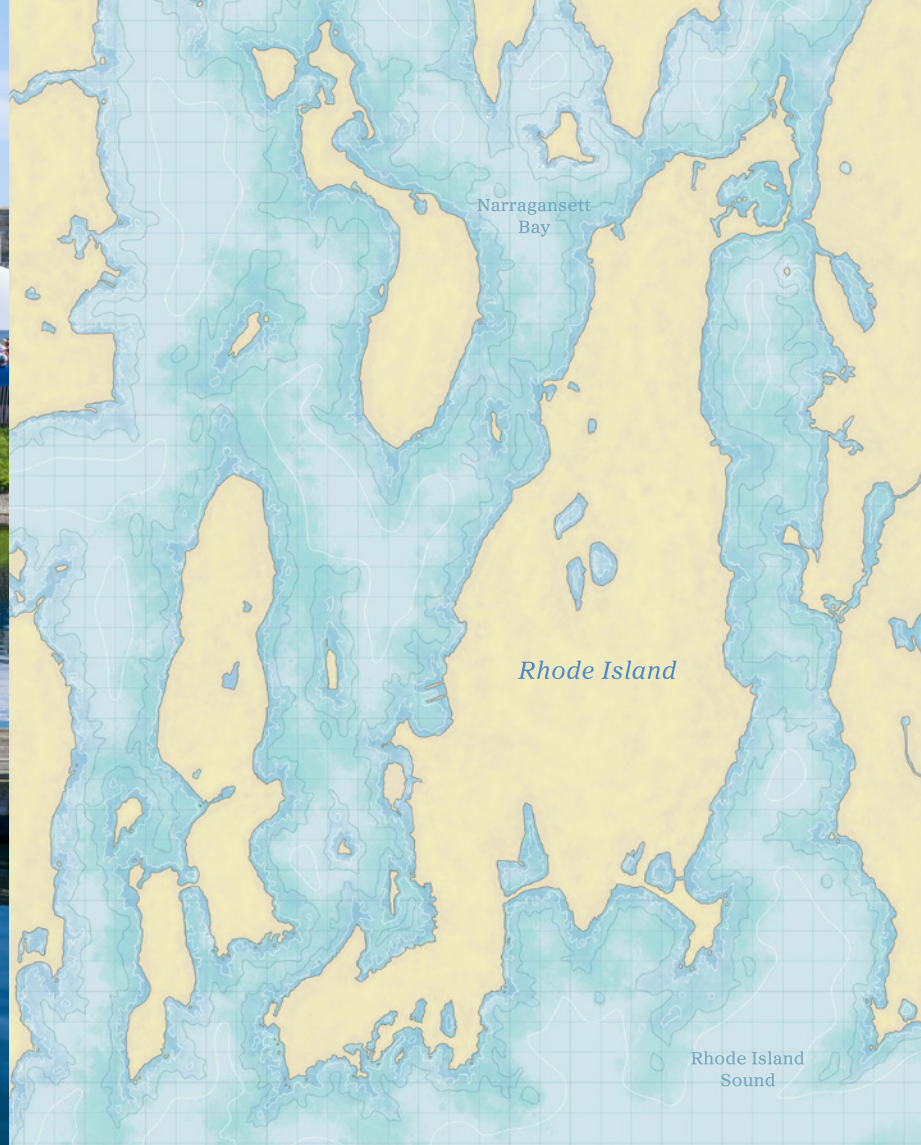
### Day Six: Seal Harbor to Southwest Harbor

**4 Nautical Miles - 30 Minute Sail**

Start the morning slowly with one last paddle around the Maine shoreline before breakfast. Raise the sails for the last time while you return to Southwest Harbor!

# Festival Cruises

Each summer, Newport, RI hosts some of the world's premier folk and jazz artists at Fort Adams for two weekends of music, food, and celebration. Enjoy the festivals from the top decks of *Andromeda* and get access to the grounds as part of your charter experience.

### Day One: Newport Harbor

Board *Andromeda* in Newport Harbor sitting off of the Newport Festival main stage and relax on your first night onboard. Enjoy the music with snacks, apps, and cocktails. Watch the sun set from the aft deck while dining on a perfectly prepared meal.

### Day Two: Newport Folk Festival

Head to Fort Adams State Park in the morning and spend your day listening to live music with backstage access courtesy of VIP day passes. Once the festival ends, take a harbor cruise in the tender or relax on the boat and enjoy another expertly curated meal.

### Day Three: Folk or Jazz Festival & Club Reception

Anchored within earshot of Folk Festival, soak in the sounds of the artists or buzz to the festival on the tender. Join B&G and other Members on the dock for a Club festival reception, get backstage to enjoy all of the sights and sounds of the festival with some of the world's premier musicians, or take *Andromeda* for a sail and enjoy the views off of Narragansett Bay. For dinner, enjoy the chef's tasting at Giusto in downtown Newport. The meal will be tailored to fit your preferences.

### Day Four: Swimming, Music, & More

Start your day off visiting Mackerel Cove for a refreshing swim & some sun. Afterwards head back to the harbor for your final lunch onboard before returning to shore.

# Nantucket Race Week

Nantucket Race Week draws the attention of sailors all over New England. The weekend is capped off with Opera House Cup, an elegant pursuit race made up of vintage wooden yachts that cannot be missed. This signature event itinerary offers enjoyment on and off the water courtesy of Barton & Gray.

### Day One: Newport

Spend the afternoon relaxing onboard *Andromeda* before heading into town for a chef's tasting menu at Newport's premier waterfront restaurant, Giusto.

### Day Two: Newport to Cuttyhunk

**25 Nautical Miles - 3 Hour, 15 Minute Sail**

Sail from Narragansett Bay to Cuttyhunk Island. Take the tender ashore and make the way to Lookout Tower Park to take in the scenery before returning to *Andromeda* for an expertly prepared meal on the aft deck.

### Day Three: Cuttyhunk to Edgartown

**25 Nautical Miles - 3 Hour, 15 Minute Sail**

Start the morning off slowly before sailing to Edgartown. Explore the town and beaches or hop on a B&G Hinckley and zip up to Larsen's for seafood and sunset.

### Day Four: Edgartown to Nantucket

**23 Nautical Miles - 3 Hour Sail**

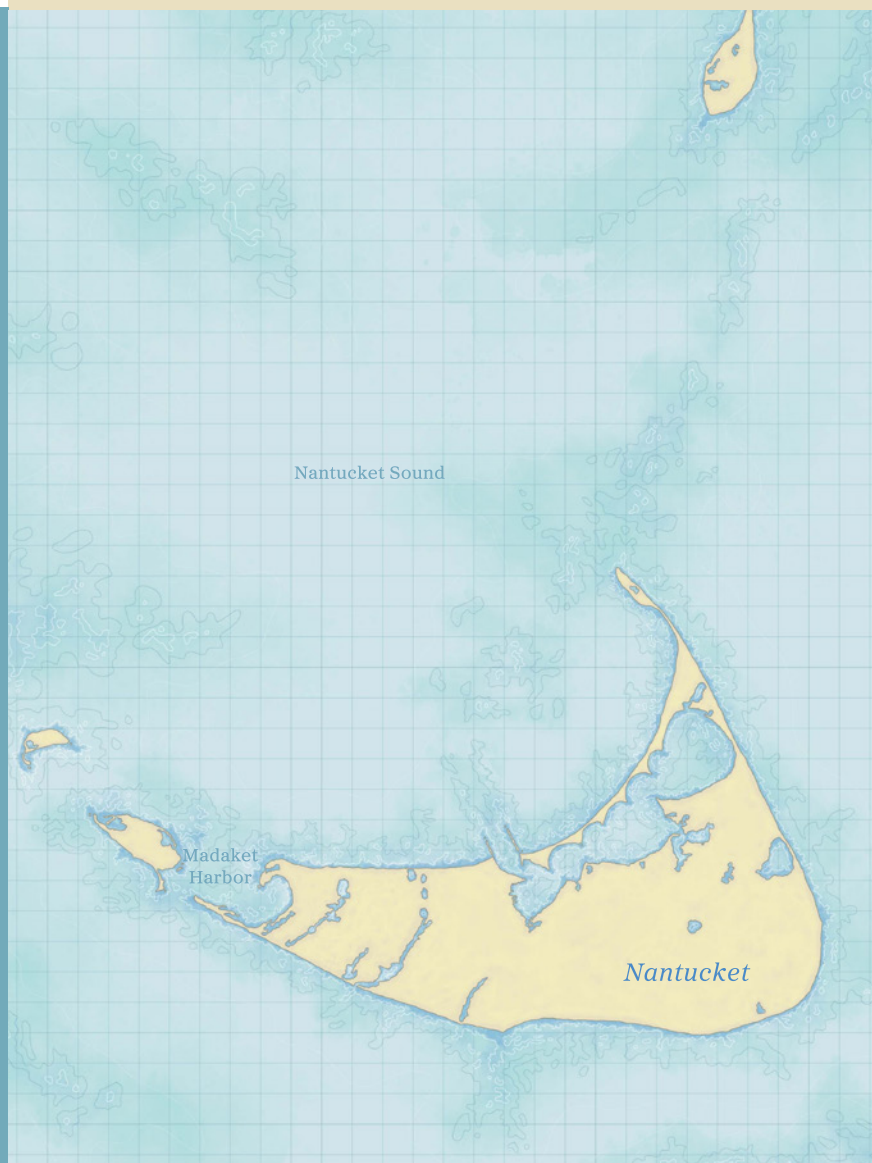
Find the best seat in the sun while being swept away to New England's favorite island, Nantucket! Take a short walk into town and dine at one of the many amazing restaurants before heading back to *Andromeda* for a nightcap.

### Day Five: Clambake and Classic Yacht Exhibition

# British Virgin Islands

### Day One: Soper's Hole, Tortola to Jost Van Dyke

**4 Nautical Miles - 45 Minute Sail**

Join the Crew in the bustling marina town of Soper's Hole, Tortola. Push off to Sandy Spit, a must see tiny sand island perfect for beach picnics. Complete the perfect first day at White Bay with one of Soggy Dollar's world famous Painkillers.

### Day Two: Jost Van Dyke to Great Guana Cay

**10 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour, 45 Minute Sail**

Take in the dramatic north shore of Tortola as you set sail for Guana Island. Enjoy pristine snorkeling in and out of caves and finish your evening with an unobstructed sunset view.

### Day Three: Great Guana Cay to Cooper Island

**13 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Weave through the Camano Islands and cross the Sir Francis Drake Channel. Stop in Virgin Gorda to explore The Baths where granite rock formations tower above the shoreline. Enjoy a sunset sail to Cooper Island for an evening under the stars.

### Day Four: Cooper Island to Peter Island

**4 Nautical Miles - 45 Minute Sail**

A short sail brings you to Peter Island. Enjoy the amenities of the Peter Island Resort or continue to the eastern side and tuck yourself away in remote bays with not another boat in sight.

### Day Five: Peter Island to Norman Island

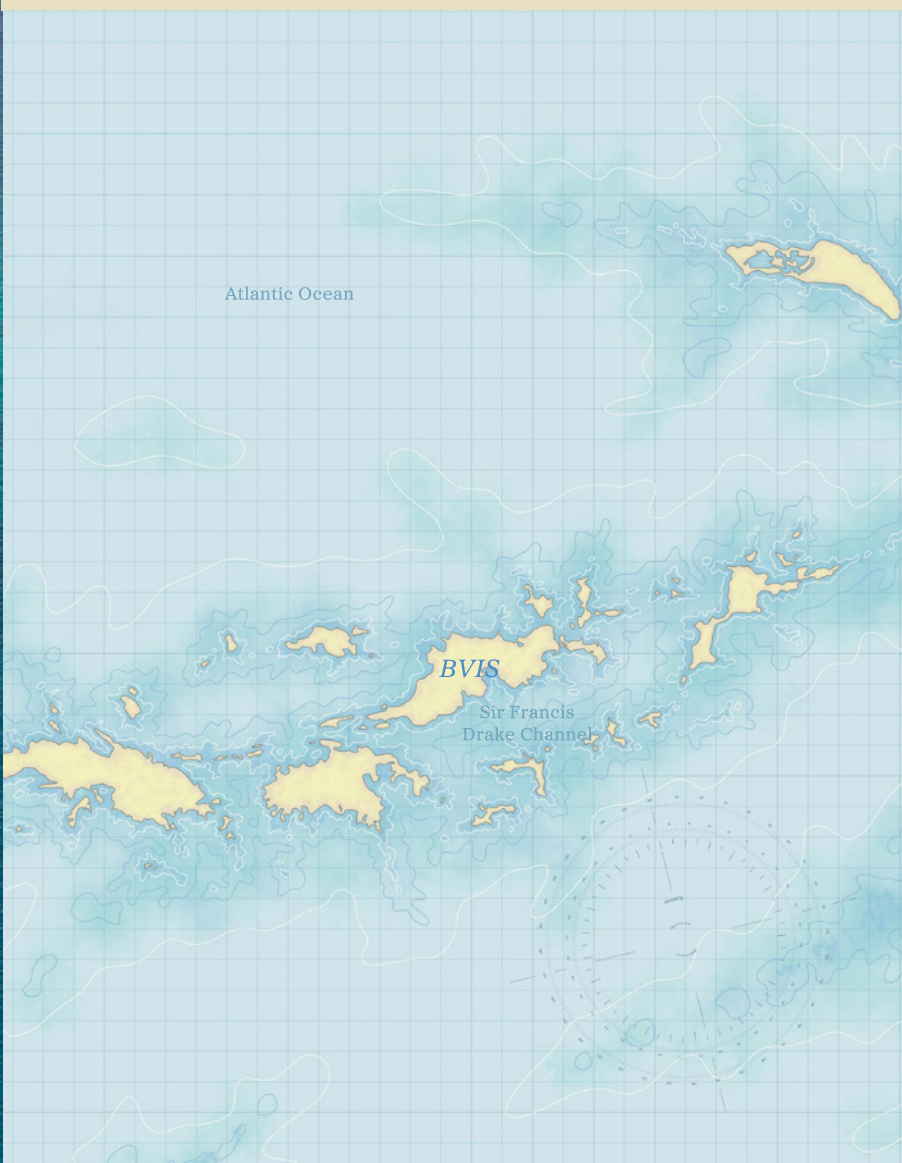
**5 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour Sail**

Enjoy an action packed last full day with several stops for snorkeling and swimming until you drop anchor in "The Bight" at Norman Island. Rich in pirate history, Norman Island is the inspiration for the novel Treasure Island by Robert Louis Stevenson. Relax at the Pirates Bight restaurant or be the life of the party on the famous floating bar, Willy T.

### Day Six: Norman Island to Soper's Hole, Tortola

**5.5 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour Sail**

Soak in the sun on the bow as you make your way back to Soper's Hole where transportation will be awaiting to deliver you and your guests to the airport.

# The Bucket Race

### Day One: Simpson Bay to Île Fourchue

**13 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour Sail**

Enjoy your first passage due south to the French island of Île Fourchue. Nestled between four rocky peaks you will find an idyllic anchorage for a peaceful night.

### Day Two: Île Fourchue to Gustavia

**5 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour Sail**

Witness yachting royalty at the St. Barths Bucket Regatta. Steeped in history since 1995, this prestigious event gathers magnificent super yachts exceeding 100 feet for a spirited yet gentlemanly competition. Forget prize money – the allure lies in claiming the coveted Bucket Cup and the bragging rights that come with it. Watch these sailing titans glide across the Caribbean waters, a testament to human innovation and a display of awe-inspiring beauty.

### Day Three: Gustavia

Enjoy a personally curated breakfast onboard before you head out to catch the stunning beauty and exhilaration of the race competitors. Mingle with sailors and enthusiasts post races downtown.

### Day Four: Gustavia to Anse de Colombier

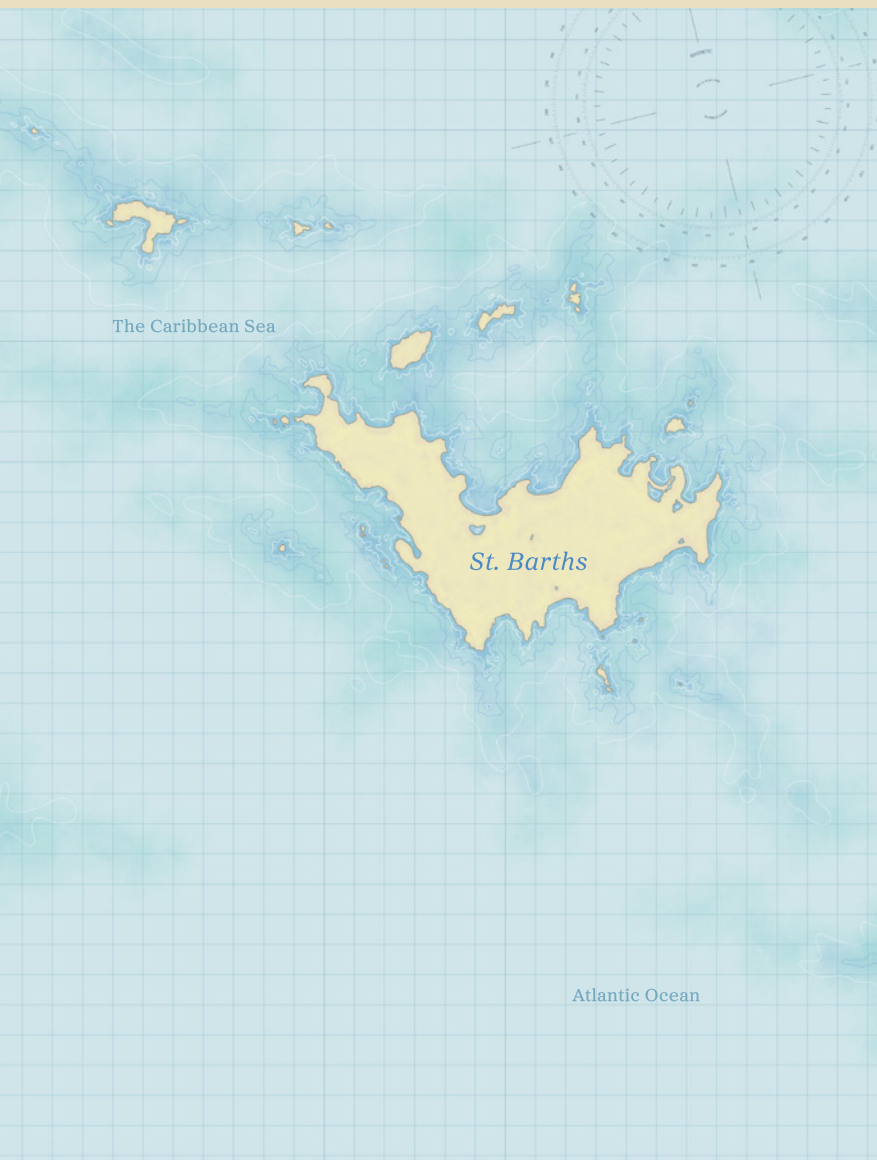
**3 Nautical Miles - 30 Minute Sail**

Leave the buzz of Gustavia behind and unwind on the island's pristine white sand beaches. Enjoy the secluded bay only accessible by yacht for your last night onboard.

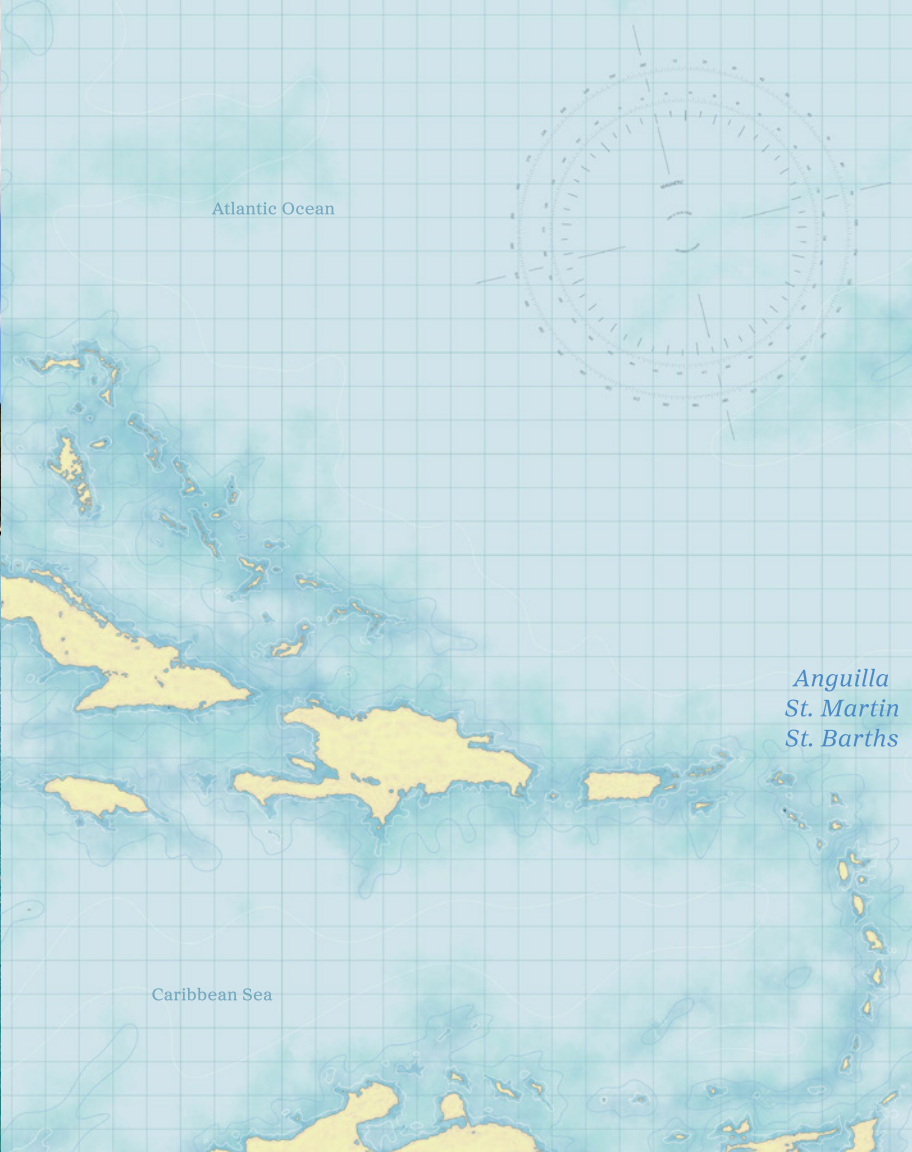
### Day Five: Anse de Colombier to Simpson Bay

**15 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Raise the sails and soak in the sun as you and the Crew return to Simpson Bay conveniently located right near the St. Martin airport.

# St. Martin, St. Barths, Anguilla

### Day One: Simpson Bay to Road Bay

**16 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 45 Minute Sail**

Join the Crew in the bustling Simpson Bay of St. Martin. Sail north to Anguilla and stroll down pristine white sand beaches, check out the beach bars or lounge with a cocktail on the bow.

### Day Two: Road Bay to Crocus Bay

**4 Nautical Miles - 45 Minute Sail**

A short sail brings you to a peaceful and secluded anchorage with cliffs rising from white sand beaches. Crocus Bay boasts calm waters and top notch snorkeling.

### Day Three: Crocus Bay to Great Bay, Philipsburg

**17 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Set sail back to Dutch St. Martin's capitol, Philipsburg. Stroll through the vibrant downtown dotted with colorful houses, shops, and cafes.

### Day Four: Great Bay to Gustavia

**13 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Bask in the sun as you make way to St. Barthélemy. History whispers from weathered forts guarding the harbor entrance. Explore Fort Gustave, a reminder of the island's intriguing Swedish past. Later, meander past the charming boutiques and art galleries, picking up unique souvenirs or indulging in a splurge.

### Day Five: Gustavia to Anse de Colombier

**8 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

Anchoring off Anse de Colombier, a secluded beach on St. Barths, is like stepping into a postcard. Pristine turquoise water laps at the powdery white sand beach, while lush hills frame the tranquil scene.

### Day Six: Anse de Colombier to Simpson Bay

**13 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour Sail**

Take it all in during your final sail back to Simpson Bay conveniently located close to the St. Maarten Airport (SXM).

# Bitter End Bookend

**Day One: North Sound to Anegada**

**17 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 45 Minute Sail**

Spend the night before pick up at the exclusive Bitter End Yacht Club. Wake to find your boat docked and ready to push off towards Anegada. Take in the Caribbean sea as you set sail to Anegada's sandy shores.

**Day Two: Anegada**

An entire day in Anegada is a must. Have the Crew pack a picnic and rent scooters to experience miles of beaches with your footprints the only mark. Finish the night around a driftwood fire and treat yourself to a freshly caught grilled spiny Anegada lobster.

**Day Three: Anegada to Jost Van Dyke**

**26 Nautical Miles - 3 Hour, 45 Minute Sail**

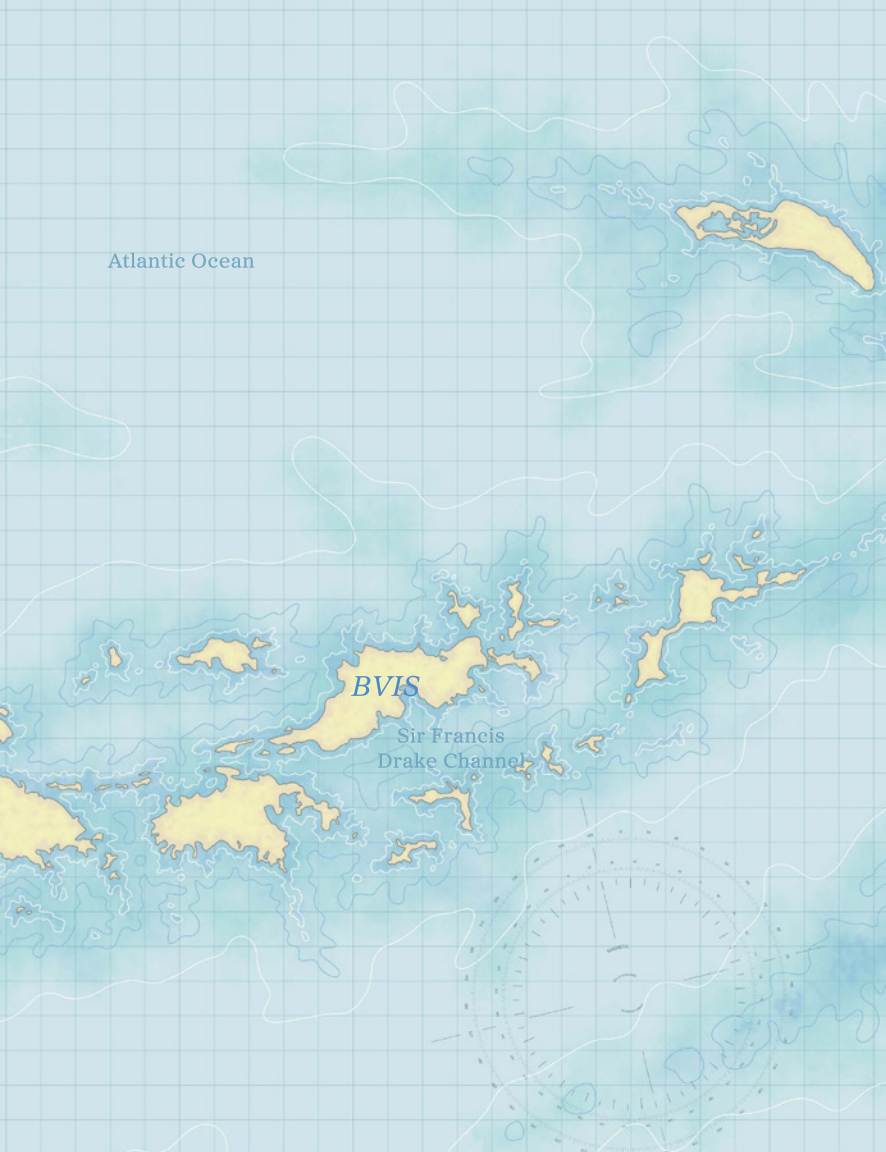
**Day Five: Cooper Island to North Sound**

**14 Nautical Miles - 2 Hour, 30 Minute Sail**

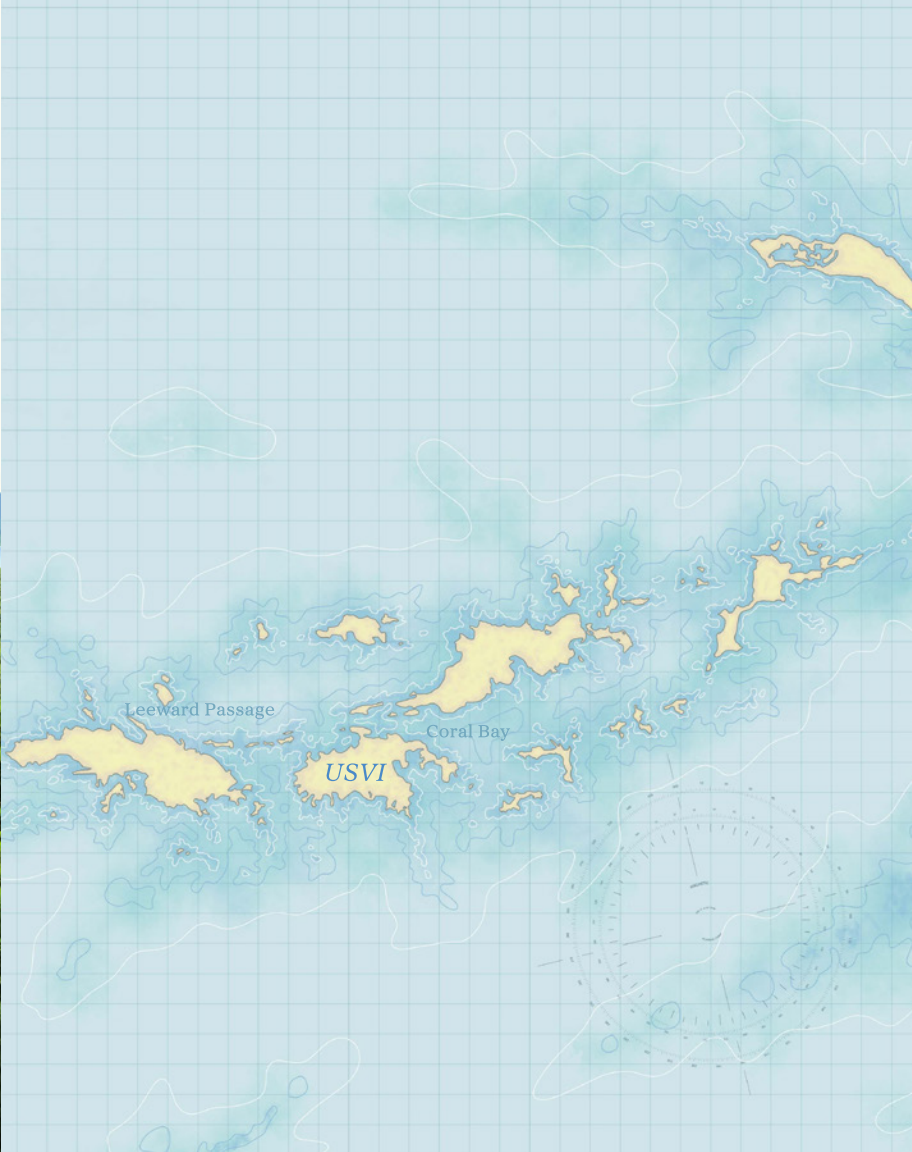

### Day Five: Elbow Cay to Tilloo Cay

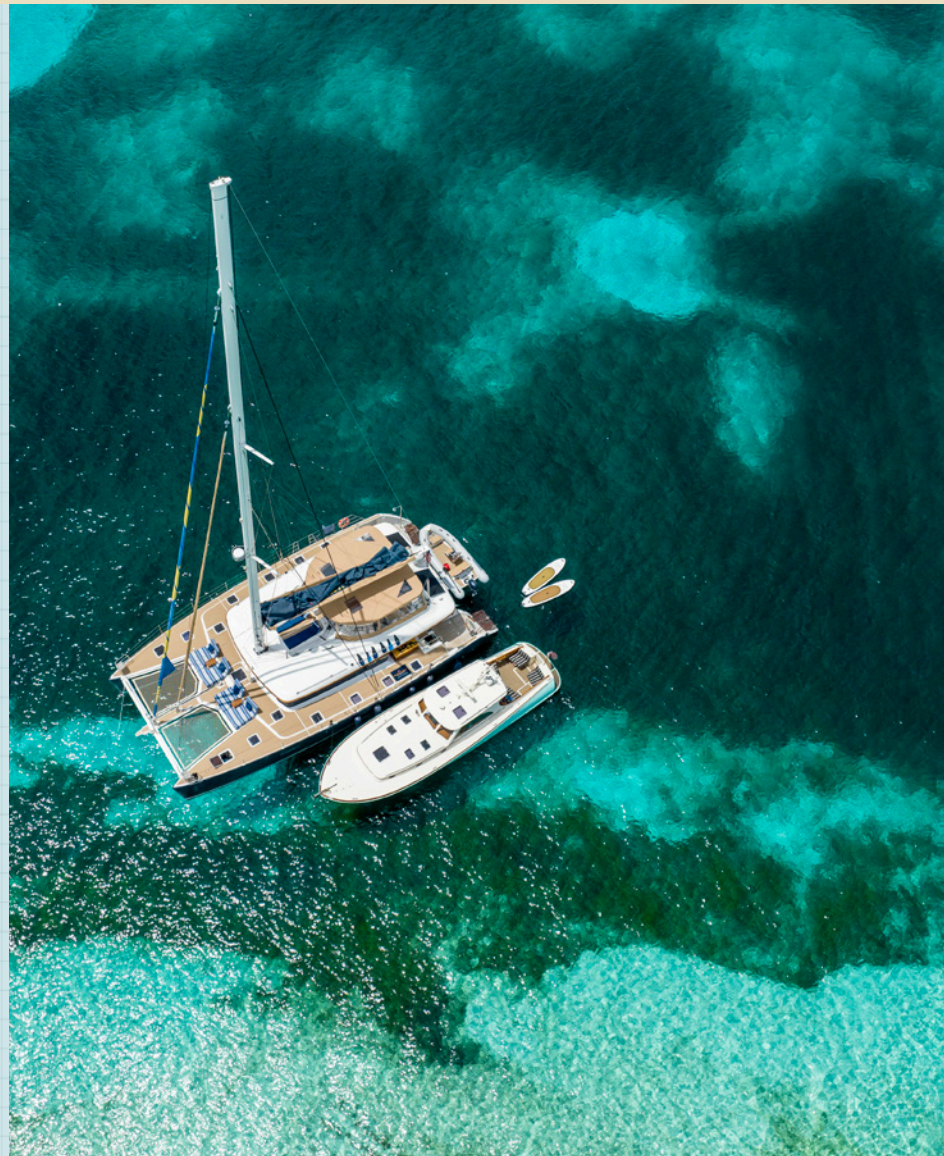
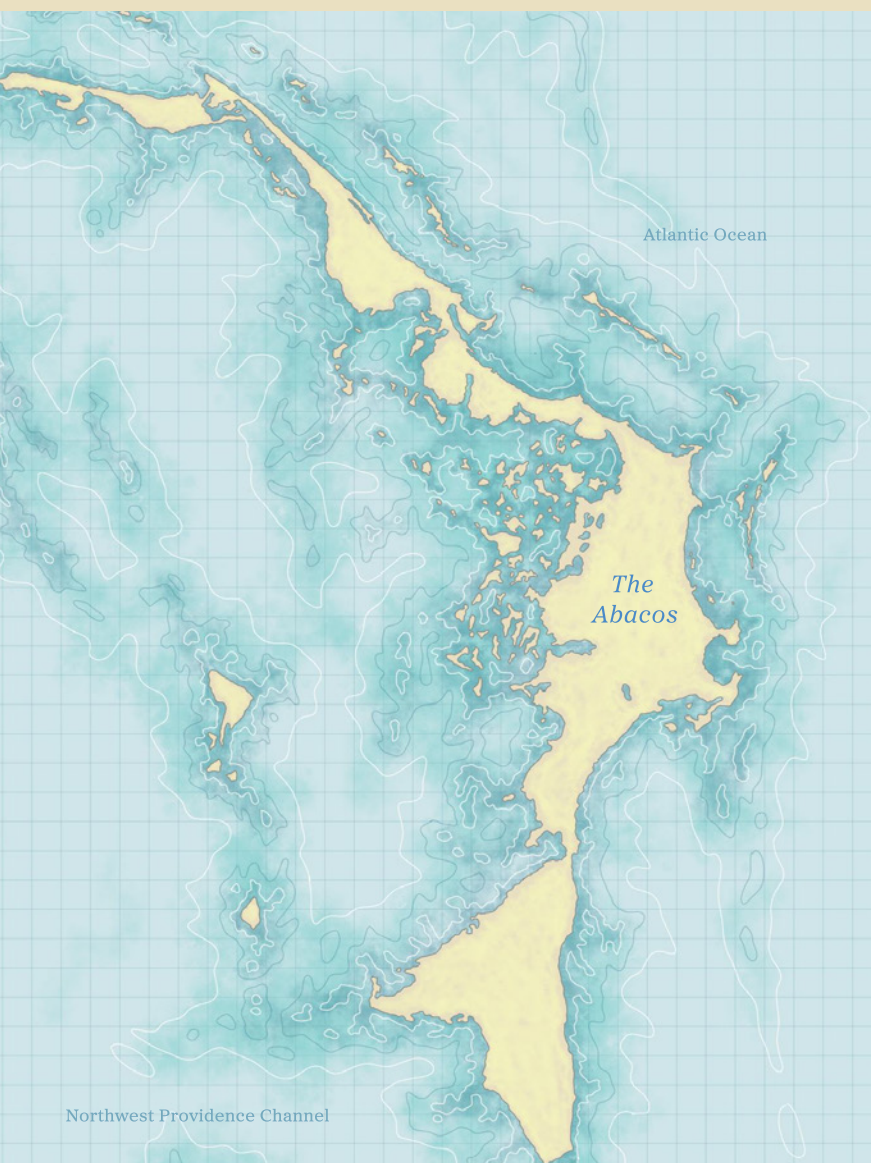
**6 Nautical Miles - 1 Hour Sail**

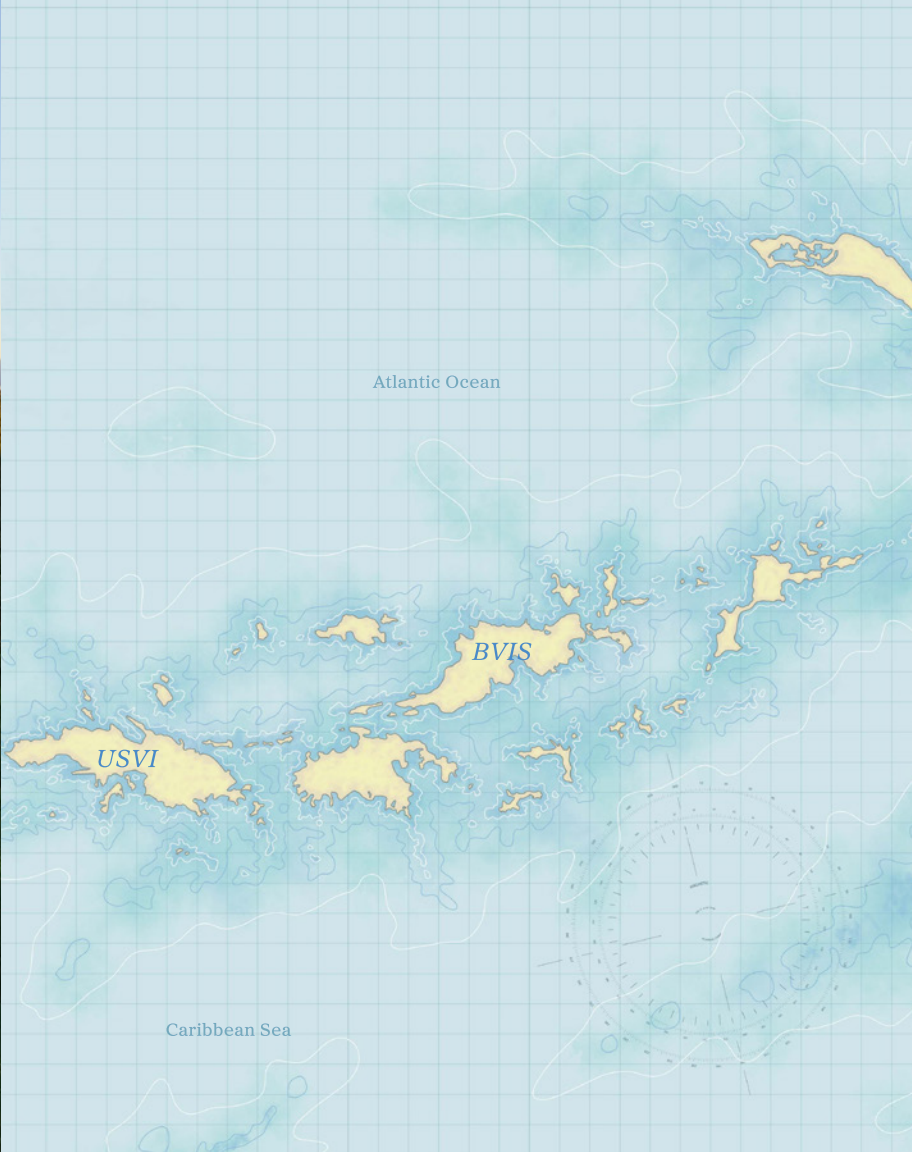
### Day Six: Tilloo Cay to Marsh Harbor

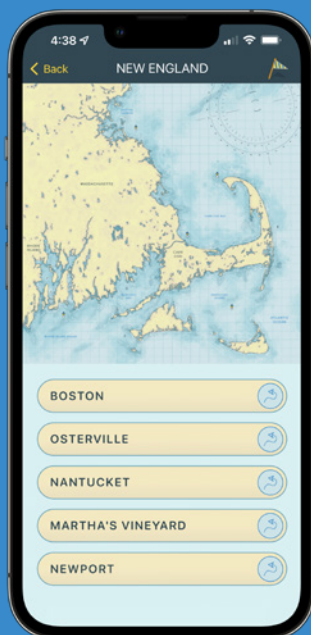
